

# Allerton High celebrates another year of outstanding GCSE results!

Students and staff worked incredibly hard, securing excellent outcomes again this summer. There were some fabulous results by individual students in Years 9-13 in a wide range of subjects.

## Exceptional GCSE results 2017

Year 11 students at Allerton High achieved excellent results in a wide range of subjects again this year, despite considerable national change and turbulence. **61%** achieved 5-9 grades in both English and Maths. A 5 is comparable to C+/B.

Attainment across all subjects was very high with an average score of 55.4 across 8 subjects (an average of Grade B). This is similar to last year's performance which placed us in the top 10% of schools nationally for attainment. The proportion of top grades was also very high, with 32% achieving 7-9 in Maths, 28% achieving 7-9 in English and 30% of students achieving an average of a grade A or higher.

47% of our students achieved the English Baccalaureate [5-9 in English, Maths and A\*-C in 2 Sciences, MFL, History and/or geography] and early indications are that this is very high compared to national figures.

**Progress 8 (P8)** defines how much progress students make from their starting point (across 8 subjects). The expectation is that a school's average P8 score will be somewhere in the region of -0.5 to 0.5. Our progress 8 score is 0.85 which provisionally places the school in the top 5% nationally in terms of progress.

We are delighted everyone's hard work paid off and that all students are now pursuing Post-16 courses or apprenticeships of their choice, with the majority studying at Allerton High School.

## Overall summary

- Progress 8 score of **0.85**
- **61%** of students achieved 5 to 9 grades in English and in Maths
- **76%** of students achieved 4 to 9 grades in English and in Maths
- **47%** of our students achieved the English Baccalaureate (5 to 9 in English & Maths and A\*-C in 2 Sciences, Modern Foreign Languages and History or Geography.)
- Attainment 8 is **55.4**
- The average GCSE grade achieved was a **grade B**.  
(This shows students achieved higher grades than they were expected to from their key stage 2 starting points.)
- **83%** of students achieved A\*-C in Science
- **All** students achieved at least 1 A\*-C grade

## English

- **79%** of students achieved 4 to 9 in English
- **67%** of students achieved 5 to 9 in English
- **28%** of students achieved 5 to 9 in English

## Maths

- **83%** of students achieved 4 to 9 in English
- **70%** of students achieved 5 to 9 in English
- **32%** of students achieved 5 to 9 in English
