### WHAT QUALITIES & SKILLS WILL BE DEVELOPED?

Art Skills: Drawing, Painting, Mixed media 3D

### YEAR 7

The topics covered in year 7 will be:

Autumn Term	Spring Term	Summer Term
<p><b>Tinga Tinga</b></p> <p>Students learn about the Tanzanian artist Edward Tinga Tinga. Realistic animal drawings are developed into a Tinga Tinga style final piece. Students use synthesis to develop and refine their ideas.</p>	<p><b>Landscape</b></p> <p>Students learn about Van Gogh and Hundertwasser. Mixed media skills are used to produce a series of landscapes.</p>	<p><b>3D Creatures</b></p> <p>Students create 3D monsters using papier Mache. Realistic drawings are made of insects, fish and other animals. Synthesis is used to create a series of ideas before the best idea is made into a 3D creature.</p>

### YEAR 8

The topics covered in year 8 will be:

Autumn Term	Spring Term	Summer Term
<p><b>Sweet Stuff</b></p> <p>Students learn about the artists Sarah Graham and Wayne Thiebaud. Students respond to the work of the artists using ceramics.</p>	<p><b>Surrealism</b></p> <p>Students learn how to develop ideas from observational drawings into surrealism. A range of artists are used as inspiration.</p>	<p><b>Personal Portrait</b></p> <p>Students learn about Pop Art and create a self-portrait in the style of Roy Lichtenstein</p>
