HOW IS THE COURSE ORGANISED & ASSESSED?

Unit 2, 3 and 6 will be internally moderated and will be awarded a Pass, Merit or Distinction whereas Unit 1 will be external marked and will again be award a Pass, Merit or Distinction. All the grades will be collected together to reach your overall level.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

IS HEALTH AND SOCIAL CARE THE SAME AS CHILDCARE?

No. Students will cover some similar aspects for example child development however the majority of the course gives students a broader view of all health and social care client groups not just children.

IS HEALTH AND SOCIAL CARE ALL ABOUT BABIES?

No, Health and Social touches upon the development of babies however is a very broad subject that focuses on the many varying topics linked to Health and Social care provision.

IS THERE A LOT OF WRITING?

Yes, this qualification requires you to complete three portfolios of written work by the end of year 11. You are also required to obtain **24 core points** in year 10 in order to obtain the level 2 qualification and therefore you need to ensure that your written coursework is of a high standard.
