COURSE LEVEL 2 | NCFE CACHE Level 2 Diploma for the Early Years Practitioner

WHAT IS CHILDCARE?

This one year course will help you develop the necessary knowledge and skills to become an early year's practitioner. You will be introduced to aspects of working with babies and young children by looking at the importance of play, observing children and planning activities to support their development. In order to support these skills you will spend two days in placement every week, which offers you the opportunity to gain an understanding of the current early year's curriculum and observe children's development first hand.

At the end of level 2 you will be offered the opportunity to progress onto level 3, provided you have met the entry requirements.

METHOD OF ASSESSMENT

Assessment is through written coursework and observations in a childcare setting.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Five or more grades at GCSE level 3 or above.

FUTURE PROSPECTS

This course will give you the background knowledge and skills to progress onto level 3. Once you have achieved your level 3 you will be able to work in: day nurseries, nursery schools, school reception classes, pre-schools or be a childminder or a nanny.
