COURSE LEVEL 1,2 & 3 | Diploma in Bricklaying Trades

WHAT IS CONSTRUCTION?

“The qualification to help you build a better future”

These are one year courses in bricklaying. They concentrate on both practical skills and essential underpinning knowledge of construction technology and Health and Safety. The courses are recognised by industry and provide the skills necessary to achieve an NVQ qualification which at level 2 are the minimum industry standard to be classed as ‘qualified’.

Although the qualifications are to enter the industry at craft level, with levels 2 and 3 these provide a firm ‘foundation’ to enable progression to a career at a higher technical or management level.

METHOD OF ASSESSMENT

You are required to build a portfolio which includes evidence from:

- Your practical skills being checked by assessor observation
- Verbal questioning by your assessor
- Completion of written tasks in training booklets
- Written or online exams

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Interview. Progression to level 3 subject to successful completion of L2.

FUTURE PROSPECTS

Sufficient skill levels and background knowledge to pursue NVQ qualifications in the workplace. Progression to a level 3 diploma which provides more advanced training including that of a supervisory and organisational nature to aid future progression to higher levels of employment within the industry.
