To achieve this Level 3 qualification you will have to pass a total of eight units:

- 302-Monitor and Maintain health and safety practice in salon
- 303-Hairdressing consultation support for colleagues on hair services
- 304-Cut women's hair to create a variety of looks
- 305-Style and dress hair using a variety of techniques
- 306-Colour hair to create a variety of looks
- 311- Bridal hairstyling
- 312-Cut men's hair
- 410-Hair colour correction

#### METHOD OF ASSESSMENT

Learners will produce evidence by:

- Being observed by your assessor
- Being asked questions by your assessor
- Completing assignments
- Keeping documents, e.g. work logs & client records
- Completing written or online tests

You will keep all this evidence in a portfolio. You will regularly be given feedback by your assessor and you will receive further training if you need it. If your assessor tells you that you are competent after an assessment, it will be recorded on the forms in your logbook.
