The NVQ Diploma is for anyone wanting to work in the beauty therapy industry it is highly practical and provides the skills and understanding required to practice as a beauty therapist. NVQs are work based qualifications designed to reflect the different skills and current treatment trends required by beauty therapists when they begin working in the industry. NVQs are proof that you have the right skills to do your job well, which is why so many employers look for people who have one. METHOD OF ASSESSMENT

To achieve the NVQ level 2 beauty therapy diploma you will cover:

- Ensure responsibility for actions to reduce risks to health and safety
- Provide manicure and pedicure
- Promote additional services and products to clients
- Develop and maintain effectiveness at work
- Provide facial skin care
- Carry out waxing
- Enhance the appearance of eyebrows and eyelashes
- Provide make-up
- Fulfil salon reception duties

To gain your Diploma you need to show you've got a particular set of skills. You will work with your teacher and assessor in a realistic working environment, demonstrating your skills on paying clients and you'll be assessed as you learn. For each unit your assessor watches and asks questions as you perform a task, looks at a portfolio of work that you've built as formal evidence of your learning. Then they confirm you've got the skills to do the job well. You will keep all this evidence in a portfolio. You will be given feedback by your assessor and you will receive further training if you need it.
