## Learning Strategies

Applying knowledge to exam questions, buddying up and testing each other, self-quizzing after reading part of a topic, re-writing text/information in a different way. Flash cards of key terms; look, cover, write and check, reading over class note after each lesson, creating mind maps

## Writing Long Answer Questions

Read the question carefully. Plan before you start writing. Use scaffolds and suggested structures when practising. Study exemplars and use the mark scheme to identify strengths and weaknesses. Practise.

## Independent Study

Learn key vocabulary. Go over class notes to ensure you understand them, revise content so far e.g. from the start of the year so you don't forget it, practice planning or answering exam questions, make key definition/theory/studies lists to help retain important knowledge. Read relevant chapter in textbook and access revision videos through Cambridge Elevate. Re-read powerpoints/ resources from shared area/ Ashnet.
