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Ashlawn School Sixth Form Mobile Phone/iPod.

Clearly Mobile Phones and iPods are an important part of 21st Century lives – enhanced communication and improved individual safety. However, it is important that their use at School does not have a detrimental effect on students' learning.

In recognition of Sixth Form students' developing maturity and to encourage individual and collective responsibility. Sixth Form students are allowed to bring a mobile phones/iPods to school. Students who bring a mobile phones/iPods to school are responsible for the safe keeping at all times. Ashlawn School can not be held liable for any loss or damage caused to mobile phones/iPods.

Mobile Phones/iPods use:

- Students may use Mobile Phones/iPods in the **Sixth Form Canteen**.
- *Students may only use a mobile phone device during lessons if given specific permission by a member of staff. This must only be used for an appropriate learning activity.*
- Mobile Phones and iPods **must not** be used anywhere else on the School site

Mobile Phone/iPod misuse sanctions: "2 strikes and out":

The following sanctions will apply to a student who uses a mobile phone/iPod anywhere else on the School site other than the **Sixth Form Canteen**:

Strike 1:

- Mobile phone/iPod confiscated. Final warning issued.

Strike 2:

- Mobile phone/iPod confiscated. To be collected by parent/guardian from school.
