Ashlawn School Uniform Policy

Our school uniform regulations are clear.—It is essential that all staff insist on these regulations being adhered to.

They are aimed to ensure students wear clothes which demonstrate similarity, are neat and tidy, are suitable for most school activities, are readily available and reasonably priced.

The correct wearing of these clothes gives messages to students, parents and the wider community about standards, expectations, working habits and so on.

Our policy is to ensure that all students comply and most of our students readily do this.

We attain this by the following actions:

- **Regular reminders of requirements – oral and written**
 - These will occur formally in assemblies, form periods, newsletters and informally when staff take opportunities to remind and inform. Parents will be reminded of standards expected annually by letter/email or text.
- **Oral warning to students not in correct dress**
 - All staff to do this consistently and refer to form tutor.
- **Report persistent offenders to form tutors**
 - All staff to do this consistently.
- **Form Tutors/Heads of Year to give formal instruction, warning**
 - If unsuccessful.
- **Letter to parents(s) – by Head of Year**
 - If unsuccessful.
- **Student to work off timetable for day eg. in Inclusion Room or with Head of Year/senior member of staff**
 - Work to be set with minimum disruption to regular teacher and class.
- **If difficulties persist, parent(s) will be contacted again and further steps considered**
 - This might involve Heads of Year, Heads of Upper/Lower school/6th Form, Deputy Head or Head Teacher.

Finally, WE The school shall be the arbiters of decency, good taste and appropriateness.
