Why is it important to study Art?

To understand the range of technical skills that you will need to learn and apply. In Art practice is everything.

How many lessons will I have over two weeks?

You will have 2 lessons.

What will I be studying in Year 7?

You will be studying a range of different styles, medias and techniques. We cover a range of different topics in year 7 from gargoyles, lettering, botanicals, animals, architectural features and portrait.

What subject specific skills will I be developing in Year 7?

Students in year 7 learn how to manipulate medias and refine their technical skills throughout Key Stage 3. We focus on developing your ability to apply tones/shades, shading, blending and neatness with a wide variety of medias.

What could I do before I come to Ashlawn to prepare for my studies in Art?
