In Service Training (INSET) for Curriculum Development

Our schools, across both primary and secondary stages, have recently been working together to review our curriculum models. We aim to develop new approaches which draw on the best (evidence based) practice nationally and which allow us to share resources across the schools in our Trust. We are very excited about this and know that it will be a key plank in delivering our vision which speaks of:

“A rich and exciting curriculum where our pupils thrive and develop character.”

You will appreciate that introducing such significant change is both complex and time-consuming, so we want to set aside some time for our teachers and support staff to do this work. Our Headteachers and Trust Leaders have therefore elected to add a sixth INSET day to the schedule for the coming Academic Year. This will be 20th July 2020, which schools will take as a disaggregated day (i.e. they will deliver this time across a number of twilight sessions spaced across the year). We are very confident that this time will be extremely well invested and that the impact in classrooms and in children’s learning will be both immediate and long-term.

Schools will communicate with you separately to let you know the other INSET days that they have chosen.
