Why Did Jesus Teach The Lord's Prayer As The Way To Pray?

The children will learn about the importance of prayer to Christians, and in particular, The Lord's Prayer.

THEME

Theme name: The Animal Kingdom

Subject Driver: Science

In **Science**, children will be learning about different types of animals. They will sort animals into different groups based on their characteristics. Children will be finding out what animals need to be able to survive and they will be learning about life cycles. In **PSHE** they will research how to look after animals with care and sensitivity and consider how their actions have an impact on the environment. In **History** they will learn about David Attenborough's work with animals. In **Geography** they will learn about where different animals come from, their habitats and how certain animals survive in extreme environments. In **Art** the children will be creating animal prints. For **Music** lessons this year the children will learn to use their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes.

PE: Athletics and Dance
