Literacy

Key Text: Flat Stanley by Jeff Brown

Writing: Instructions, informal letters/emails and nonsense poems.

Reading: To listen to, discuss and express opinions about a range of poetry, stories and non-fiction at a level beyond which they could read independently.

Text and Word: Use of suffixes –er and –est to form comparisons of adjectives and adverbs.

Punctuation: To begin to use commas in lists and exclamation marks in exclamatory sentences.

Sentence structure: Expanded noun phrases for description and specification.

Maths

- Use mathematical vocabulary to describe position, direction and movement
- Tell and write the time to five minutes, including quarter past/to the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times.
- Use efficient methods to solve problems
- Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times tables

CURRICULUM INFORMATION

RE

An introduction to the basic beliefs and practices of the Sikh faith.

Children will learn that Sikhism is one of the main religions of the world. They will reflect on the Sikh statements of belief and compare with those of other faiths.

THEME

Theme name: It's a Small World

Subject Driver: Geography

In this theme, children will be learning about the continents and oceans of the world and the countries and capital cities of the UK in **Geography**. They will learn how to use a map to find different countries and will use atlases and globes. In **Music** they will listen to folk music from another country.

In **Science** the children will be looking at the habitats of different plants and animals. They will compare different habitats and learn about the conditions in those habitats. They will also be introduced to the term 'micro-habitat'. They will gather and record data to help answer questions.

In **DT**, children will investigate different pop-ups before designing and creating their own pop-up Flat Stanley.

In **PSHE** they will learn about relationships, including communication, feelings and behaviour.

PE: Swimming and athletics

COMPUTING: Children will learn how to use the internet to search for information effectively.
