Children will understand that Christians believe that God calls us in different ways and that God stands by them at all times. They will understand that we have difficult decisions to make in life and the right choices are not always the easiest or most popular.

THEME

Theme name: Food, Glorious Food

Subject Driver: Science

In this theme, in **Science** children will be learning about the need for the right types of nutrition in humans. They will learn the simple functions of the digestive system and explore different types of teeth and their simple function. Children will investigate how different liquids affect teeth through careful and systematic observation. In **Art**, children will experiment with different grades of pencil when sketching different forms and shapes. In **Design and Technology**, children will research, design, make and evaluate a healthy sandwich and learn about making healthy eating choices from a balanced diet. In **Geography**, children will use globes, atlases and digital computer mapping to locate countries around the world. In **PSHE**, children will learn about different influences on health and wellbeing and the meaning of the term 'habit'. In **Music** the children will explore what is meant by a pentatonic scale. They will write compositions using pentatonic scales.
