I would also like to request that parents ensure that access to the side alley is not blocked during drop-off time. Many children come to school on scooters and bicycles, and it is proving very difficult for them to navigate their way through all the parents to the scooter and bike stands.

MAINTENANCE PAYMENTS 2015/2016

Receipts will be issued for all payments, however, there may be a delay in receiving a receipt for a BACS payment as I will only be able to check receipt of these at the end of each month. With many thanks for your cooperation.

Maintenance payments are essential in allowing Governors the ability to ensure that the school building is well maintained. It also allows access to extra funding from the Diocese, enabling for example the extensive re-configuration of the school that happened this year.
