Pupil Premium at BVPS

The Pupil Premium is additional funding given to publically funded schools in England. It is to help close the attainment gap between disadvantaged pupils and their peers.



Funding for 2018-2019

Here at BVPS we have Pupil Premium children within all year groups. Our allocated funding across the School for the 2018-2019 academic year is £42,240

Targeted Support and Quality Teaching

£34,138

Enabling children to learn in 1:1 and small adult supported groups, with highly qualified staff, when needed, is paid for through our Pupil Premium budget. This School Year, we have appointed a member of staff who works solely with Pupil Premium children supporting them 1:1 with academic targets, emotional needs, runs homework groups for Key Stage 2 children and provides parental support as and when necessary.

Reach and Resilience

School Development Plan

£1000

As a School, our Development Plan aims to improve the resilience of all our children and encourage them to reach higher. Staff receive regular training to improve the strategies they use in order to teaching children to motivate themselves and plan, monitor and evaluate their own learning.



Nurture Groups

£1000

Children can attend our Nurture Group, known as Acorns, to help them learn strategies in order to help reduce any social, emotional and behavioural barriers they may have towards learning. This improves progress within class so that children can reach higher.

School Trips and Clubs

£6,102

All Pupil Premium children are given the opportunity to attend School Trips and After School Clubs. These trips are invaluable as allow them to experience enrichment opportunities which have a positive impact with learning.
