



## Year 7 Catch Up Grant 2015-6

Creation of ARC group (Accelerated Results Club)	Specialist teacher	£9,600	<p>Reading – Of the 11 learners who took part in interventions for reading, 91% (10 pupils) made accelerated progress with an average increase in threshold of 2.1 levels. (In order for pupils at Broadstone Middle to make expected progress, they need to stay within their threshold.)</p> <p>Writing – Of the 15 learners who took part in writing interventions, 100% made accelerated progress with an average increase in threshold of 3.8 levels.</p> <p>Maths – Of the 16 learners who took part in maths interventions, 100% made accelerated progress with an average increase in threshold of 3.5 levels.</p>

### Next Steps for Year 7 moving to Year 8
