Beowulf Concert

We are delighted to inform you that our school choir has been invited to take part in a performance of 'Beowulf' at Poole Lighthouse on 5th July 2019, starting at 7pm and finishing at approximately 8.15pm.

Written for harp, solo soprano, narrator and children's choir, with a strong folk influence, Beowulf is an epic drama set by Armonico Consort's composer-in-residence Toby Young. The performances will feature international baroque soprano **Elin Manahan Thomas** and a guest narrator.

Your child has been selected to be a part of the choir and perform at the above event. As part of the commitment, your child will need to attend choir rehearsals on a Tuesday and Thursday lunch time. There will also be an additional rehearsal on the afternoon of the performance.

We are aware that the 5th July is also transfer day, however we are confident that we will still leave school on time to make the rehearsal before the show. We will leave school at 3:15pm, by minibus, for the afternoon rehearsal starting at 4pm at the Lighthouse in Poole. Within the venue, we have use of an area where children will be based throughout the event. Staff accompanying the choir on this visit are Miss Palmer and Mrs Curtis.

Performers should wear a school uniform for the event.

Please ensure that your child brings a packed tea with them on the day, in a named, disposable bag. We strongly recommend that your child brings TWO named bottles of water with them for the rehearsals and evening concert (plastic, no glass please) so that their throats do not become dehydrated. No hot food is to be brought into the hall and please ask children to avoid bringing anything with nuts in case there are other children nearby with severe allergies. No money will be required on this trip, unless your child wishes to purchase a souvenir programme.

All children need to be collected from the Lighthouse foyer after the performance which is due to finish at 8.15pm.
