Soft Transition Day – Thursday 27th June 2019

Transition from school to school can cause anxieties for students but we are aware that transition from Year group to Year group and Key Stage to Key Stage can also be quite a change and ‘culture shock’ for our students.

With that in mind, we are delighted to inform you that we have organised a transition day in addition to the official Transfer day on Friday 5th July.

Next Thursday, **27th June**, your child will move into their next Year group with their current class and current class teacher. They will experience a different part of the school and classrooms and have a taster of what life is like on a typical day in the next year group. For our Year 6 students, this is particularly important as they will have been used to spending nearly all day every day with their class teacher in one part of the school. On this transition day, they will be based in year 7 form rooms and will travel around the school each lesson to meet some of the Key Stage 3 staff and have taster Key stage 3 lessons. We believe that this will help to give them a taster of life in Year 7 which is different to that of Transfer day when they will spend all day with just their new form tutor.
