Dear Parents and Carers,

Sports Day 2019

The Sporting event of the season is finally here...Broadstone Middle School's Sport Days 2019! We will be holding two whole school sports days so our pupils have the opportunity to take part in both field and track events. The field events will run on Monday 10th June at various points during the day. Due to the nature of the field events and health and safety, there will be no spectators for this day but following this there will be a whole school Sports Day for track events on **Thursday 13th June** that we would like to invite all our parents and carers to attend.

Timings of the morning:-

9am onwards – parents are welcome to arrive and find a space on the field – the spectators zone will be sign posted for you.

9.15am – pupils walk down to the field and sit in their houses – zones will be sign posted

9.20am – Welcome and introduction to the day

9.30am – Official start of track events

12.45pm (approx.) – End of the events

1pm – Lunchtime – picnic on the field for pupils, parents and staff

1.50pm – Pupils back into houses and results announced

Equipment needed for the day - Pupils will need to come to school in their PE kits with a coloured t-shirt relating to their house (Dyson – Yellow, Rowling – Red, Attenborough - Purple, Da Vinci – green). If you are having trouble locating the correct coloured t-shirt for your child, they can wear their normal PE t-shirt and we will provide a coloured sticker for them to wear. We would recommend pupils also bring a hat, sunglasses, water bottle and have a high factor sunscreen already applied as the field has very little shade.

The Social Hub - Our brilliant Social Hub (PTA) will be providing refreshments for the day. They will be supplying hot drinks and soft drinks as well as snacks and pastries and even strawberries and cream! They are also very kindly donating money for certificates and a trophy for winning individuals / winning house.

Spectators - Please feel free to bring along blankets and fold out chairs to watch the events – we want as many supporters as possible to help cheer on the pupils as they take part in their races. After Sports Day has finished, parents and carers are welcome to stay and join in with our picnic lunch. We also ask that during the events, pupils stay with their houses rather than sitting with family. It is more manageable if pupils are all sat together, rather than spread out.
