World Book Day 2019

Thursday 7th March 2019 is World Book Day, 2019. To mark this occasion, all pupils will need to bring in a favourite, age-appropriate book (fiction or non-fiction) from home which they will share with other pupils across the school during lesson 5.

We would also like to give pupils an opportunity to dress up as a **fictional** character (preferably from the world of books and comics but also TV, film and video games – no real people or celebrities). They could come as a single character or team up with friends – there will be prizes!

If your child is going to dress up, we would ask them to bring in a voluntary donation (i.e. £1) to go towards replenishing our reading books in school.


Please note: this is not a non-uniform day and pupils who choose not to dress up will be required to wear normal school uniform.

In addition, we will also be hosting a Travelling Books book fair during the week beginning Monday 18th March 2019 which will be open to all pupils at lunchtime and after school to pupils and parents until 4.00pm on the Wednesday, Thursday and Friday (20th-22nd March 2019).

Every pupil will receive a £1 World Book Day Token, redeemable at our book fair as well as at participating book stores. These tokens can also be used to exchange for a free book from a small selection printed on the token.

We look forward to celebrating reading with your child.
