Overview

PE in KS4 is based around game play with the opportunity to put learnt skills into game situations. Throughout KS4 the skills are further developed to strengthen the game play. Pupils are encouraged to take on more leadership roles, such as referring, leading small group activities and coaching. Each lesson is made up of group, individual, practical activities.

Units studied:
