Dear Parent/Carer

As we come to the end of another academic year, can I first of all take this opportunity to thank you all for your support over the last twelve months. Our Sixth Form students would not be the successes they are without the help and guidance they receive outside of school as well as within the community at Cannock Chase High School.

To highlight the support that students receive at Cannock Chase High School, we have enjoyed a successful few weeks:

- Year 12 students took part in a trip to the University of Leicester to experience university life and have a taster of lectures and university accommodation.
- For those Year 12 students who are looking to attend university, they took part in a UCAS information day with advice and guidance on completing their university application personal statement. For those Year 12 students who are looking to move into full-time employment or an apprenticeship, students were able to take part in a mock interview with leading employers, and seek advice on presenting and completing job applications.
- Prospective Year 12 students took part in a full and diverse taster week, including team building activities, advice from prospective employers and taster lessons of Level 2 and Level 3 courses at Cannock Chase High School and Cardinal Griffin Catholic College.
- A record number of Year 12 students are this year undertaking summer school placements as part of the UniQ and Sutton Trust summer school programmes. Students are visiting, amongst other universities, Oxford University, Cambridge University, University of Birmingham and Keele University.

As you may be aware, I am excited to be taking the position of Assistant Headteacher for Sixth Form over the course of the next academic year. As I am sure you will agree, Mr Reynolds has done a fantastic job leading the Sixth Form, and we wish him every success as he moves into the Key Stage 4 standards role at school. 
- Female students should have their shoulders covered;
