## Electronic Signing in System

As students may have indicated, we have now introduced an electronic signing in system for all Sixth Form students. This means that students must scan in or out at the start and end of each day, as well as anytime they leave site. Students are also required to scan in for study periods as well as complete paper registers. Initial trials of the system have proved to be very successful, and the introduction of the system allows us to further safeguard our Sixth Form students.

## Exams

The busy external exam season begins on Friday 3 May, and does not finish until Wednesday 26 June. The Wednesday 26 June is now classed as an Examination Contingency Day, which may be used in the event of a national emergency should exams be cancelled. Students have been issued with their examination timetables, and should be preparing for their final exams. Whilst we feel it is hugely important that students have a break over the Easter holidays, we also ask for your support in ensuring that students are revising during this time as well. A number of revision sessions for the Sixth Form are being held over the holidays, which we encourage students to attend. A timetable for those sessions is now available on the Sixth Form page of the school website. Students cannot get the time back over Easter which they can spend revising, and often regret when they haven't used it appropriately.
