NEW LEISURE CENTRE PROPOSALS

We are writing to you to let you know that the Royal Borough of Windsor & Maidenhead is looking at plans for a new leisure centre on the Charters School campus which would improve the existing facilities already available at your school.

We are really keen to hear your views on the proposals and the design of the building, as we want to make sure that we are offering you and your school the very best sport facilities we can.

The proposed site would be located on the old sports courts next to the school drop-off area on Charters Road and could open in 2020 should it be approved.

The new centre would be built to provide additional facilities for you and the school, as well as providing new facilities for residents to use during the day, complementing those already at Charters Leisure Centre, which will remain open. This would involve a multi-million pound investment from the Royal Borough.

The new Oaks Leisure Centre could include:

- A six-lane, 25m swimming pool.
- A 60-station gym.
- A dance studio and spinning studio.
- A sports hall with eight badminton courts.
- 100 additional car parking spaces.

The layout of the proposed centre is shown on the reverse of this letter. You will see that the design separates public use of the pool, gym and dance studios, with separate changing areas for school use and access to the sports hall.

We are also proposing additional car parking on site and a new drop-off area off Devenish Road. It is proposed that the Maine Centre is relocated to a refurbished building replacing the existing Youth and Community Centre.

The existing Charters Leisure Centre would remain in operation offering gym, sports hall and squash facilities to its current programme during and following the build.

There will be opportunities to view and comment on the design during the summer in local shopping centres and libraries to help us develop the design. Full details to be announced in due course. You can also let us know your thoughts on the proposals by contacting us

Once we have gathered views from you and other local residents outline designs will be developed further so we can submit a planning application, subject to funding approval in early 2019.





Proposed design of the building and sketch of location:




