- ❑ **Phones**, toys, games and cards must stay at home

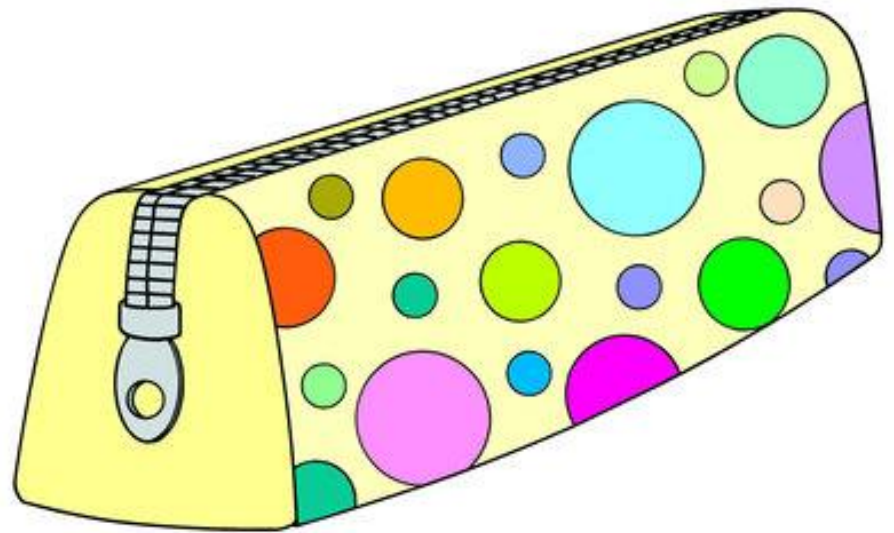




# A small pencil case containing ...

## Year 4 topics and themes ...

**Human Impact:** A study about animals, food chains and the environment.

**Very Important Bear:** Through English and Computing a study of film and its history.

**The Romans:** A study of the Roman empire and its impact on Britain.

**Hinduism and India:** Exploring the beliefs, practices and impact of Hinduism, locally and globally.

**Extreme Earth:** A study of natural disasters and extreme weather.

**Invaders and Settlers:** A historical study of Anglo-Saxons and Vikings.



# The year ahead – what to look forward to...

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- ❑ Swimming- for a whole term, approx. 9-10 sessions  
(4K in autumn, followed by 4M and then 4S)
- ❑ Curriculum based trips  
Hounslow Urban Farm, Neasden Temple, Lookout Centre, possibly a theatre trip
- ❑ A few tests –twice during the year, the same as in Year 3
- ❑ Christmas Carol Concert, Viking workshop, dance workshops, year group assembly, visit to the Neasden temple (25<sup>th</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> September)





# Homework

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**Key Principles:** at Chase Bridge, homework is valued because it:

- ❑ provides opportunities for parents to be involved in their children's education, reinforcing the partnership between home and school
- ❑ enables children to practise skills and consolidate their learning
- ❑ helps develop lifelong skills, such as responsibility, endeavour, organisation and self-discipline

**In year 4: Due on a Wednesday, given out on a Friday.**

- ❑ Daily reading with comments in your child's reading record
- ❑ Weekly spelling with linked grammar task, spelling test on a Friday.
- ❑ Weekly maths activities
- ❑ On-line maths homework
- ❑ Optional activities linked to topics to promote greater interest and depth of understanding



# Being prepared – parents

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- ❑ Ensure **prompt arrival each morning** & regular attendance
- ❑ If **driving**, please park safely and responsibly
- ❑ Please check your child's home-school **reading record**
- ❑ You can use the **reading record to send in any messages** or feedback on your child's work
- ❑ Make sure you have your **child's logins** to access on-line resources at home
- ❑ Make sure the office have got up-to-date **contact details** (see sheet handed out of our most up-to-date information)
