Congratulations to Dinel, Ryan, Pranav and Constantin who have all earned medals in this year's prestigious national **Primary Maths Challenge**. Dinel and Constantin won silver and Pranav and Ryan bronze medals placing them in the top 1% in the country from a total of 68,000 entries. Well done to them as well as the other children in year 6 that took part – many of whom only just missed out on medals.

To get to that standard the children have worked very hard and practised a great deal with on-line resources such as Mathletics.
