WORK ON OXFORD UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS ENERGY LINK TO START ON 14 NOVEMBER

Work on the Energy Link will now commence with the construction of a temporary residents' car park at the JR on 14 November and begin on local roads on 21 November. It will run until 13 April 2017 in Highfield and finish 19 May on Churchill Drive. Vital Energi is now using three dig teams, which has halved the original schedule. Vital Energi and Oxford University Hospitals (OUH) are also working very closely with Access to Headington and the Winvic developers to ensure that all our works are coordinated.

On 28 November, work will commence at two locations: All Saints Road junction with Barrington Close onto Lime Walk (where there will be temporary three-way traffic lights) and from Latimer Road down to the junction with Latimer Grange. County Council approved signage will be positioned in adjacent roads to alert drivers to road closures.

OUH is currently preparing a 12-page leaflet (that has also had considerable input from local Councillors, residents and the City Council Planning Committee that will be posted on the OUH/Energy website at <http://www.ouh.nhs.uk/about/developments/energy/default.aspx> and widely circulated to stakeholders.
