The first phase of Access to Headington is due to begin on Monday 17 October 2016

We are writing to make you aware of major roadworks taking place at the Gypsy Lane / Old Road/ Roosevelt Drive / Warneford Lane road junction, beginning on Monday 17 October.

This major infrastructure project, called Access to Headington, will impact on journey times to and from school, and the council is advising all travellers using these roads to allow extra time. “We will be installing 4-way temporary traffic lights at the junction of Old Road-Roosevelt Drive-Gypsy Lane-Warneford Lane, which will be manually controlled during the day to help traffic flow.

The first part of this work will involve us working on the islands on Warneford Lane, Old Road and Roosevelt Drive. This will take approximately 2 weeks before we start on the corners of the junction. This junction improvement will be complete by March 2017.

The site working hours are 7:30am to 6pm Monday to Thursday, 7:30am to 4:30pm on Friday and 7:30am – 1pm on Saturdays.”
