Academy Uniform – 2017/18

- Purple school blazer with school badge, to be worn at all times
- Plain **mid grey** trousers, tailored not tight. No black trousers, jeans or leggings
- Plain white shirt with top button done up
- Mid grey kilt style skirt, (**on or below the knee**) or Academy summer dress in the summer term
- School tie as appropriate to year group, showing the dragon below the knot and done up to cover top button
- Academy mid grey sweater with school logo. **No hoodies**
- Plain black leather/leather look polished shoes that sit below ankle. No trainers, boots, air force shoes, canvas shoes, plimsolls, suede shoes, patent shoes, ballet pumps, coloured stitching/laces, logos or buckles
- Plain **black** or **grey** socks or tights. No ribbons or frills
- **Plain black** or **navy blue** overcoat. One small logo is permitted, but no bigger than the palm of the hand

- Large **plain black** or **navy blue** school bag that can hold an A4 book without being folded. No fashion bags or bags with frills
- Religious headwear must be plain **navy blue** or **black**
- Hair accessories and scarves must be navy blue or black. Only plain dark blue or black woolly hats are permitted, if there is cold weather
- One **plain small gold** or **silver stud** in each earlobe is permitted. No other piercings are permitted - No diamante, glass, pearl, shaped, or coloured earrings. No nose, mouth or eyebrow studs or piercings
- No other jewellery is permitted except a wrist watch. No bracelets, necklaces or rings
- No **false, varnished, coloured, or long** nails are permitted
- Excessive make up or false eyelashes are not permitted
- No sculptured hairstyles, unnatural hair colours, Mohicans **or shaved patterns in facial hair or hairstyles** allowed
- No extremes of fashion
- Only official school badges to be pinned to clothing (blazer)
- Coats, scarves and hats must be removed when inside the building.

If the uniform rules are not followed...

then please note that you will be asked to go home and change (once we have contacted your parent/carer).

Or you will be removed from mainstream learning until your appearance is adjusted (i.e. false nails removed), or the correct piece of uniform is brought in for you.

If you are unable to wear the correct uniform for a medical reason then you must have written confirmation from a Doctor/Hospital, otherwise you will be removed from mainstream learning and placed in the Removal Classroom.
