1) Subject Categories

a) ART in NATURE

i) Show off the beauty in nature with a striking picture.

b) WORLD OF WATER

i) Underwater pictures are usually worth the effort

ii) But it is enough just to have some water somewhere in the frame as long as the subject has some relationship to it.

c) MINI NATURE RESERVE

i) Find an area to manage for wildlife and research best practice on RSPB.org

ii) Photograph it when the light looks good.

iii) Put in the caption where it is.

iv) This will be entered in to Bristol School's Nature Reserve too.

2) Age Categories

a) Juniors Y1 – Y3

b) Juniors Y4 – Y6

c) Seniors

d) Staff + Parents + Alumni + Governors

3) Submissions

a) They must be submitted digitally (see below) by **6th June 2017**.

b) Pictures can be taken any time in the past **but must not have been submitted previously**.

c) Pictures must be emailed, one picture per message, to the competition organiser Tom Walmsley at Clifton High School with the caption in the email message body.

d) Files larger than 5Mb should be sent via free (FTP) providers such as www.HighTail.com

f) **DEADLINE IS AT MIDNIGHT ON 6th June 2017**

4) Conditions of Entry (*standard for photographic competitions*)

a) The following details are standard for photo competitions – **although no entrance fees**.

b) Submitted images will be available to Clifton High school to display internally and externally. They will also be available to CHS to market the competition and the School by association.

c) Maximum of ten entries per subject category.

d) Images must be submitted in a digital format although the original does not need to have been taken digitally.

e) Images can be taken from any point in time or place.

f) Still image format: JPEGs (high resolution, should be 2Mb to 9Mb file size). Exceptions can be made for strong entries made on mobile phones.

g) No borders, watermarks and signatures should be included.

h) If you make significant digital adjustments in your pictures they will still be judged if they represent the true nature of the subject and your adjustments are included in the email – see Captions below.

5) Captions

- a) A written description about your pictures, known as a Caption, should be emailed along with the picture in the email message. The Caption should be a 10 – 50 words giving some background.

6) Ethics *(standard for photographic competitions)*

- a) Any breach of these will constitute a breach of the rules.
- b) Entrants are required to report on the natural world in a way that is both creative and honest. Images entered must not attempt to deceive the viewer or misrepresent the reality of nature.
- c) Entrants must not do anything to injure or distress any animals or destroy their habitat in an attempt to secure an image.
- d) Entrants are not permitted to submit stills and/or moving images that feature captive or farm animals, family pets, and/or cultivated plants.
- e) Caption information supplied must be complete, true and accurate. Disguising or misrepresenting the origin of the image will constitute a breach of the Rules.
- f) Each entrant must either be the sole owner or joint owner of the copyright in the image(s) submitted.
- g) The decision of the Organisers on all matters relating to the Competition is final and binding. No negotiation will be considered. The Organisers reserve the right to amend the Rules and to waive breach of the Rules at their sole discretion, acting reasonably.

7) Judging *(standard for photographic competitions)*

- a) A panel of experts on photography and the category subjects will be appointed to judge the competition.
- b) Judges may move an image to a more suitable category if necessary.

8) Prizes

- a) **Over –all prize** = 1 to 1 workshop + massive calendar + Amazon voucher £5
- b) **Category / Age group winners** = Massive calendars + Amazon voucher £5
- c) **Commended** = Amazon vouchers £5
