Dormers Wells High School Outcomes Reach Top 10% Nationally for Exceptional Student Progress



High achieving

Dormers Wells High students have achieved the school's highest GCSE results ever. 63% of our students have achieved the important benchmark of gaining GCSEs at grades A*-C in both English and Mathematics. This set of results demonstrates our continual improvement of the last two years as noted by OFSTED "leaders have established an effective learning culture throughout the school". Our KS5 results have also flourished:

48% of all entries at A Level were A-B
23% of all entries at A level were A*-A*

Dormers Wells High school has achieved a **P8 score of 0.5** for our students. This means, that on average, a DWHS student scored half a GCSE grade better than would be expected nationally.

Great teaching and learning

The students' hard work has been rewarded with excellent successes. Thanks to the

support of all our staff the students have flourished and in many cases excelled in their performances. At Dormers Wells High School we continue to place the greatest importance on developing teaching and learning within our school community to ensure that our students are motivated and engaged in their learning so that they continue to achieve academic success: **top 10% nationally.**



We also have a provision for students with hearing impairment which enables these students to be fully integrated into the main school curriculum and extended school activities. "Lessons observed showed a high level of challenge for pupils". (Ofsted 2015)
