ID Cards

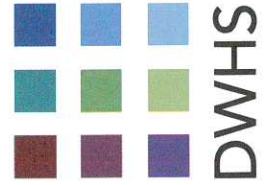
Year 7, 8, 9 and 10 students are reminded to keep their ID cards safe as these will be needed in September. The charge for replacing the ID card is £5.00.

- Income related employment and support allowance;
- Job Seekers Allowance (income based);
- Child Tax Credit or Pension Credit with Child Tax Credit and have an annual income of less than £16,190 (and not in receipt of Working Tax Credit); or
- You are assisted by the National Asylum Support Service (NASS).
