Notes from the Headteacher

This morning I visited all Year 7 classes and I was very impressed with how focussed and engaged all the students were with their learning. They are all to be congratulated for the way they have started the year. At the end of their first full week in High School, I'm sure there may be some tired young people this evening! I would also like to thank the Year 11 induction prefects for the great job they are doing, helping the younger students settle into school.

Last week I reported on the success of our students in this summer's GCSE examinations. I am delighted that this week 6 students from last year's cohort have received further good news, as they heard that some of their GCSE grades have been increased by the exam boards. This is as a result of marking reviews requested by the school. In one case a student had their English Language grade increased from a 6 to an 8. Whilst this is clearly great news for the students concerned, it would have been nice if they had received the correct grade from the exam board in August.

Late buses started running this week, and will operate on Tuesdays and Thursdays throughout the year. However they do not operate when a Parents' Evening is taking place, or if the start or end of term falls on a Tuesday or Thursday. Please note that late buses are paid for directly by the School, and are for the exclusive use of students attending after school activities. Competition


Submissions are invited for the Annual Geography Photography Competition to show human or physical geography.
