Science Lab Technician (Physics & Integrated Sciences)

Scope:

Organisation and maintenance of laboratories, assistance for the smooth running of laboratories and assistance to science teachers.

Principal tasks:

- Implementation of devices, devices and products used for teachers during practical science education (physics, integrated sciences);
- Management and maintenance of the equipment and products and equipment used;
- Construction of apparatus for physics experiments;
- Management and maintenance of computer tools (hardware and software) used for science teachers (Computer-Assisted Experimentation).
- Preparation of material needs for the school year in collaboration with the physics coordinator

Profile:

- 3 years of higher education (laboratory technician or bachelor of physics).
- In-depth knowledge of physics, knowledge of chemistry;
- Knowledge related to safety, hygiene and risk prevention in the laboratory.
- Language skills required: fluent in Dutch and English (French would be an undeniable and desirable asset);
- Very good knowledge of computer tools (MS Office) and ability to learn new software quickly;
- Organization, autonomy, ability to take initiatives.
- Availability, adaptation for exceptional activities (open days, project week, ESSS...)
