3.	<u>Parents:</u> Agenda points parents: list of comments from parents.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Long queues at the microwaves</b></li> <li>• <b>New software: no small amounts?</b></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For the moment they aren't that long.</li> <li>• 20 euro is indeed the minimum, otherwise there are more costs. The advantage is that it's immediately on the card. You don't have to wait for several days.</li> </ul>

Pupils (primary)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Don't serve us fries every Thursday, but pancakes and sushi sometimes.</b></li> <li>• <b>Other types of spaghetti, not always Bolognaise.</b></li> <li>• <b>Can we use the red and green sign again?</b></li> <li>• <b>Remark from P5FR: the food is too expensive, especially because the young children don't eat everything.</b></li> <li>• <b>It's too loud for the children in the canteen.</b></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• It's better now without the sign for the teacher who has to take all the pupils back.</li> </ul> <p>- Maybe we can use an app that says on the wall how much DB there is. Ask for the app please!</p>			

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>On Friday secondary students take their places and there aren't enough tables for them.</b></li> <li>• <b>Reactions if they drop something: it is very intimidating for the little ones.</b></li> <li>• <b>Don't use so many plastics: everything is packed in a lot of plastic!</b></li> <li>• <b>Toilets: girls: water doesn't run by itself; boys: no soap</b></li> <li>• <b>All the gum under the tables!</b></li> <li>• <b>Sharing food?</b></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- We're going to look into that, reserve tables for primary</li> <li>- We need a procedure for when they drop something. The colleagues have to do their supervision in a good way and let the students participate in this.</li> <li>- Maybe we can hang posters (positive ones) about how to behave during lunch!</li> <li>- According to the kitchen staff it's not possible to do it in a different way. Otherwise it's not hygienic (legislation).</li> <li>- Difficult to manage. Refill is only for one person, otherwise some pupils abuse this system.</li> </ul>

	Teachers (secondary)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Vegetarian day once a month</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- We'll start doing that. There will be vegetarian soup (vegetable broth) next to the regular one (with chicken broth!) ---- On December 6<sup>th</sup> Danny says that all soup will be vegetarian, they won't make it with meat broth anymore.</li> </ul>			

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sorting of the garbage?</li> </ul>	<p>- A marketing specialist will come for advice. Maybe we will try less containers to make it easier for the children.</p>			
	Teachers (primary)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Christmas lunch: can it be a little bit more special and festive? Please try the 'bûche de Noël' again, the teachers can cut it for everybody of their class.</li> <li>• Can the candy machine disappear? It's completely opposite to the health-policy of primary school</li> <li>• Soup for P1 and P2: can this be served at the tables? Or let them use a smaller tray.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Practically not possible (?) but we can put more healthy alternatives in it! It has to be agreed upon with the student delegates!!! Maybe we can also put fair trade products in it? (Oxfam)</li> <li>- Will be arranged.</li> </ul>
