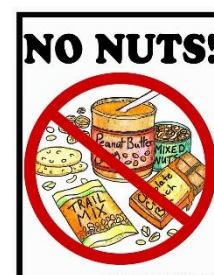
Safety outside the school gates

Unfortunately there have been several more incidents of dangerous driving and inconsiderate parking outside the Burford Close entrance to the school. Please ensure that there is no parking or stopping on any of the yellow road markings or directly in front of the school gates (even though this area is not marked with yellow zig zags). Also, many of the residents of Burford have reported incidents of parents parking on or across their driveways and have been advised to call the police should further incidents occur. We kindly request that you respect their property and park in Tesco and walk through the Tesco gate straight into our playground.
