



## INTRODUCTION

At Hertswood, we are very happy to welcome hard-working students into the Sixth Form and to assist them in making progress, whatever their chosen course of study. There are courses for everyone and you should read the subject sheets carefully to establish exactly what you would like to study and what type of course will best suit you.

### What are the entry requirements?

Students wishing to join the Sixth Form should:

- have a commitment to study
- be prepared to play a part in wider aspects of the school community
- have the correct grades to make the entry requirements for the course they are selecting

### What courses are there and how do I make my choice?

The range of courses available is extensive. However, in making your choice you need to make sure that you have the correct entry grades for the programme you are selecting. Use your current estimated grades to determine which courses are available to you.

- If you are planning to take Level 3 (A-level or BTEC) courses you should choose three courses.
- Level 2 Gateway students will be working on maths, English & key skills and a L2 qualification in Travel and Tourism.

<b>Programme</b>	<b>Entry Requirements</b>
Level 3 BTEC	5 GCSEs at 9 – 5 (A*-C) grade including Grade 5 English and maths
Level 3 A Level	5 GCSEs at 9 - 6 (A*-B) grade including Grade 6 in English or maths and a 6 or a B grade in the subject you wish to study
Level 2 Gateway	5 GCSEs at grade 3 or above

\*BTEC courses at GCSE will be accepted at Merit or Distinction grade
