'Harry Potter Studio: Workshop and Studio Tour'

To enrich students' learning experience and to provide inspiration for their future studies, the English department is offering a fantastic opportunity for 35 Year 7 pupils to attend a workshop inspired by the world-famous Harry Potter films at Warner Bros. Studio Tour London followed by a studio tour to see the authentic Harry Potter film sets and much more.

We are fortunate as the studio has an award-winning education programme which will provide us with a one-hour lesson, planned and taught by qualified teachers in a purpose-built classroom. During the workshop, students will have the opportunity to look at the journey of a film production from the script to what is seen on the big screen. They will study the processes used, focusing on artwork, plans, white card models, storyboards and the finished sets used in the *Harry Potter* film series.

After the workshop, students will have a studio tour to see many authentic, stunning costumes, breathtakingly detailed sets and intricate props which fill the Studio Tour's two soundstages and backlot.

We will be travelling to and from the event in a hired minibus, **leaving at 11am and returning by 6.00pm**. The charge is **£37** per pupil which include a workshop, transportation cost and entrance tickets to Warner Bros. Studio Tour London. The costing of the trip will be in accordance with the DfE's guidelines with respect to voluntary contributions.

Students may bring a healthy snack and must bring a packed lunch. If your child is entitled to free school meals, please indicate on the reply slip attached. They may also bring phones and cameras. There will be a stop at the studio shop. However, if students bring money or personal items with them on the trip, they do so at their own risk; the school takes no responsibility for the loss of or damage to such items.
