GCSE Maths

In order to support your child during their GCSE Maths examination this year we have planned a number of assessments with targeted interventions as results of their performance during assessments.

We have planned a set of assessments to take place on Friday 27 September and Monday 30 September. Both assessments will aim to finish around 3:30pm. Should your child have extra time, this will result in a later finish.

Having reviewed your child's performance, targeted revision sessions will start after half term. Your support in ensuring your child attends these sessions are imperative to them achieving their best potential grade in Maths. Your child should receive a personalised timetable, highlighting sessions they should attend.
