You may well already be aware of the partnership we have with Thames Valley police. They are delivering Life Lessons (PSHE) to Year 9 currently and also attended our Well-being Day for Years 7 & 10 last week to share information, advice and guidance about possible careers in the police force (they also kindly brought a large amount of fruit for our students to enjoy, which went down well with our students). We always encourage our students to understand the role of the Police in our community, including the preventative work they do around the risks faced by young people.

Next week local schools are taking advantage of a Thames Valley Police offer to have a visit from a dog handler and their dog to demonstrate the work they do. They will be visiting our school for a short time and are likely to be seen by no more than six classes due to the time constraints. We feel this would be an interesting insight into Police work that the students could experience first-hand.
