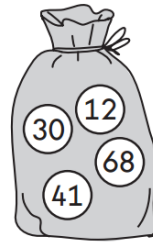

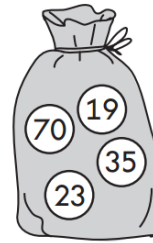
5 $15 + 3 + 3 =$
