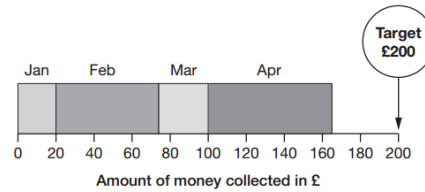

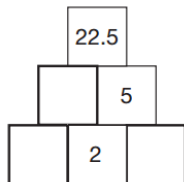
4 A school plans to collect £200 between January and May.
