Book Looks for Parents and Children

We are pleased to re-introduce our Autumn Term Book Look. This is an opportunity for parents/carers accompanied by their children to come into school to view their children's school books in the classroom, ask how they are getting on and find out what they are currently learning.

Here are some suggested questions to help guide the conversation with your child:

- Show me a piece of work you are most proud of
- Do you have a subject that you sometimes struggle with and how have you improved and shown resilience
- Praise/comment on the neatness/good presentation of work
- What is your favourite subject and why?
- What do you need to do to improve in English/Maths?
- Do you have a fixed or growth mindset? Can you show me how you demonstrate that in your work?

We are conducting these Book Look sessions to allow for you to have a more informed understanding of where your child is with their learning. Please note class teachers will not be available at the Book Look, but members of the Senior Leadership Team will be on-site and situated near to the classrooms should anyone require assistance.

The Book Look will take place as follows:

7.45am – 8.45am and 5.30pm – 6.30pm
Reception to Year 6

Busy Kids and The Hobbayne House will run as usual on both days. We ask parents to refrain from making requests to collect their children from The Hobbayne House Clubs before the 5.30pm finish as we do not have the staff to facilitate this.

A bell will be sounded ten minutes prior to the end of each session to signify that the event is coming to a close and you should make preparations to start leaving the school site. We thank you for your co-operation in this matter.
