**Here are some tips and advice to make your classroom assembly great!**

- ✓ Talk about something you have a real interest in. This could be a hobby such as: football, dancing, art or a subject that you know lots about. It could even be a recount of a recent family event or holiday.
- ✓ Engage your audience with something visual such as a picture, a video or an artefact.
- ✓ Plan out what you're going to speak about and in what order.
- ✓ Use some Power Point slides, however; don't rely on them because if you just read out what's on them this can be a little boring for your audience.
- ✓ Try to get some audience participation by asking some questions, using volunteers or having a quiz at the end.
- ✓ If you find it difficult to remember everything use palm cards with short reminders of what you need to speak about next.
- ✓ Spend time practicing your speech to members of your family or even in the mirror.
- ✓ Your presentation should last about 5 minutes so time yourself.
- ✓ Speak clearly and loud enough so that everyone can hear you in the room.
- ✓ Keep eye contact with your audience.
