



Dear Parents,

This week in phonics we have covered the following sounds **g/o/c/k**.

Can you think of words that begin with these sounds?

<b>g</b>	<b>o</b>
Start at the top. Go all the way round, up to the top, straight down, and round.	Start at the top, and go all the way round.
<b>c</b>	<b>k</b>
Start at the top, and go round.	Start at the top, and go straight down. Lift your pencil and place it next to the middle. Go into the middle, out from the middle, and flick.

**Ideas for you to do with your child:**

- Encourage your child to teach you the sound and action
- Practise writing the letter sound using the letter rhyme
- Identify objects and items around the house that begin the sounds

- Can you spot these sounds out and about e.g shop fronts, bus stops, supermarkets
