



Dear Parents,

This week in phonics we have covered the following sounds **i/n/m/d**.

Can you think of words that begin with these sounds?

i	n
Start at the top. Go straight down, and flick. Lift your pencil and put a dot at the top.	Start at the top. Go down, up and over, down and flick.
m	d
Start at the top. Go down, up and over, down, up and over, down, and flick.	Start at the middle. Go all the way round, all the way up to the top, straight down, and flick.

Ideas for you to do with your child:

- Encourage your child to teach you the sound and action
- Practise writing the letter sound using the letter rhyme
- Identify objects and items around the house that begin the sounds

- Can you spot these sounds out and about e.g shop fronts, bus stops, supermarkets
