## Y4 Brown Class Swimming Lessons

**Brown class** will attend swimming lessons from **Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> September until Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> November 2018**. Please note the lesson dates:

**11<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup> September**

**2<sup>nd</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup>, 30<sup>th</sup> October**

**6<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup> 27<sup>th</sup> November**

On the morning of your child's swimming lesson please ensure your child arrives at school by **8.50am** and goes directly to their classroom for morning registration. The coach to Gurnell will be departing at 9.00am.

Your child should bring a waterproof bag (containing a towel, a comb or brush, a handkerchief and a swimsuit (girls – one-piece swimwear please). We would encourage children to wear their swimming costumes under their school uniform and put their underwear in their swim bag.

The pool requires **all children** both boys and girls to wear swimming hats which can be purchased at the swimming pool for £1.00 or from Liza in Welfare for £1.00 this is for health and safety reasons and also to keep their hair dry. Your child will not be allowed to participate in the session if they fail to bring a swimming hat.

On the reverse of this letter are the Ealing Borough Guidance notes for parents.

On swimming days could you ensure that your child wears warm clothes that can be put on quickly and easily. Neither valuables nor money should be taken to the pool.

If your child cannot participate in a swimming lesson for any reason, could you please let the office know. All children enjoy their swimming and we look forward to following Year 4's progress.
