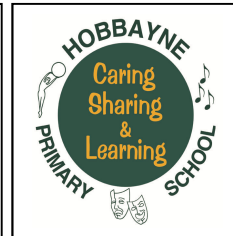

YEAR 6 TRIP TO THE HOUSES OF PARLIAMENT



VISIT VENUE: Houses of Parliament, Westminster, London, SW1A 2PW

VISIT DATE & TIMES:

Silver Class: Monday 2nd July 2018. Leave 10.15am, return by 3.45-4pm.

Burgundy Class: Thursday 5th July 2018. Leave 8.50am, return by end of school day

Platinum Class: Friday 6th July 2018. Leave 12pm, return at 4.45-5pm

(NB: Silver & Platinum parents, please make a note of this late return on your date, and Burgundy parents note your child must be in school early on Thursday 5th July 2018).

PURPOSE:

As part of our PSHE and Citizenship topics, we will be visiting the Houses of Parliament to learn about democracy and the various functions of Parliament. As the children are visiting such a prestigious venue, please note that exemplary behaviour will be expected from them for this trip.

ACTIVITIES:

The children will take part in a workshop to learn about the role of Parliament and will also have a tour of the Houses of Parliament which will hopefully include being able to walk through the House of Commons. The children may also have a meeting with our local MP (this will now be on Thursday 12th July, in school).

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS (including lunch and clothing):

The pupils will travel by public transport for free using the TFL Schools tickets.

Your child will need a packed lunch and sufficient water for the whole day (no glass bottles). They are to wear the correct school uniform and footwear and bring a lightweight/warm waterproof jacket should it be wet/cold. The children will be given a high visibility jacket so they can be easily identified on the journey.

NB: Please check the weather on this day and clothe your child appropriately.
